

Information clause regarding the processing of personal data

Pursuant to Article 13(a). 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation GDPR) are informed that:

3. Your personal data will be processed in order to perform a civil law contract concluded with you on concerning
 - performing a review*
 - promotorstwa*
4. The recipient of your personal data will be the West Pomeranian Technological Universities in Szczecin;
5. The legal basis for the processing of your personal data is Article 6(1)(1). "b" and "c" GDPR;
6. Your personal data will be stored for the period necessary to achieve the purpose listed in point 3 of the clause, and after its completion for a period consistent with the provisions of law in force in this respect;
7. You have* the right to access your data and the right to rectify, delete, limit processing, the right to transfer data, the right to object;
8. You have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body, which is the President of the Office for the Protection of Personal Data (PUODO), if you consider* that the processing of personal data violates the GDPR;
9. The data provided by you* will not be subject to disclosure to third parties;
10. The data provided by you* will not be subject to profiling;
11. The data controller will not transfer personal data to a third country or an international organisation.
